## GIVING & SERVING OPPORTUNITIES

**Kidz Worship Teachers** Want to make an eternal difference? Be a Kidz Worship teacher! Kidz Worship, for ages 4-12, happens each Sunday during the sermon time. Teachers are provided with complete lesson plans that include ideas for skits, games, lessons, and activities. (Teachers are also welcome to use their own ideas.) **Kroger Community Rewards** We have 23 households enrolled to support First Baptist through Kroger Community Rewards. Between August and November 2018 we raised \$120.79 for missions through this program.
